

The Frances Wagner Woman of Achievement Award

The Frances Wagner Award is presented annually to an outstanding Soroptimist in our Region who has demonstrated her achievements in her field of work and her service to the community. Nominees must be members in good standing.

Selection of the entrants is the responsibility of all clubs in the Region. A club may nominate more than one Soroptimist; one from another club or one from their own club. The judges score sheet is provided for more information.

Procedure:

1. The club selects the nominee(s)
2. Complete the enclosed nomination form and required information for the judges
3. Submit **four (4)** copies of the completed form – please use the forms provided.
4. Mail the **four (4)** application copies to Western Canada Region Governor-Elect:

The **deadline is March 15**. Applications must be postmarked no later than that date. ***Late applications will not be judged.***

Occasionally, in the past, applications have been lost in the mail. Because of this the Governor-Elect will acknowledge receipt of applications by March 31.

The award will be presented at the Western Canada Region Conference banquet in May.
