

## **Joyce Blake Visit Exchange Award Program**

**Due April 15**

An award is presented each year at the Western Canada Region Conference to the club, which has received the most visits and whose members have made the most visits to other clubs.

The period of eligibility is April 1 to March 31.

To be eligible, applications **must** be signed by the Club President and sent to the Region Board Member by **April 15**.

### **Rules & Conditions**

1. Soroptimist members visiting on official Region, Federation or International business do not count.
2. Attendance at a Conference or Convention does not count.
3. Newly chartered clubs receive the points for the Charter function, not the sponsor club.
4. Visits must be to a club meeting or a club sponsored function. A few members cannot get together to entertain a visitor and count points.
5. The onus will be on each club to gather and submit information as per attached guidelines.
6. Name the club visited or the one from which the visitor came. Include the member's name, club affiliation and month of visit.
7. Do not phone the results. Do not bring them to conference.
8. Attached is an entry form.
9. Appoint one person to look after the records in future years.
10. Please submit a report even if it has NIL visits recorded so the Board Member can verify her records
11. **PLEASE HAVE ENTRY FORMS IN THE MAIL OR FAX THEM BY APRIL 15 OR THEY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE...NO EXCEPTIONS.**
